**Meeting of East Wales Regional Athletics Council
18th November 2020, via Microsoft Teams
6:30pm start**

1. Apologies – Lynnette Harries, Hillary Goodger
2. Conflict of Interest (new declarations)
3. Club Updates : JT suggested asking clubs to give updates on the impact of Covid at the next few meetings.
 - a. Newport Harriers:
 - i. Very frustrated at the length of time taken to install two new cages at Newport Stadium,
 - ii. It is hard to keep up with the changes imposed by the Welsh Government, and then get these rules accepted by Newport Live. This means regular changes to our risk assessment for acceptance by Newport Live.
 - iii. There is some confusion on the rules laid out by Welsh Government and the interpretation by our members. This is also having to be explained to members, however the numbers training are now increasing but some are still wary of returning to training
 - b. Lliswerry (RJ)
 - i. coping well and updating to changes, keeping members engaged through monthly challenges, people grateful for involvement.

- ii. Smaller group training sessions via an app – when they couldn't travel, sessions put on in local areas by local members.
 - iii. Saturday training replicates parkrun. Wednesday night, groups meet and then go off in different directions (some on track) some road intervals.
 - iv. Members book sessions via the app, members have to declare themselves covid free etc.
 - v. Running club via zoom meetings, coaching resources have been stretched due to smaller groups and new coaches recruited to avoid coaching fatigue.
 - vi. Trying to keep contact with member, AGM will be held via zoom also.
- c. Fairwater (JJ), Monmouth (SP) RVAC (BAM) and Chepstow (DF) happy to update at next two meetings. SP asked what app Lliswerry are using as Monmouth use 'Team app'. RJ agreed to confirm app they use at Lliswerry.

4. Welsh Athletics AGM (JT)

- a. This year the AGM was held in form of webinar and overall, all went well.
- b. Joyce was honoured to be made a Life Member of WA at the AGM and consequently has a vote in AGM. Therefore, someone is needed to become the member for EW and have the vote at the AGM. JT asked for nominations for this role.
- c. Sue and Rob Hooper – Award of Honour, Chris Price – Meritorious Award, Neil Horsefield – Athlete Achievement.

5. Endurance (SM)

- a. Difficult to organise events, conscious that we want to keep junior athletes in the sport and looking to provide a competition for the juniors. Aiming to hold event on 5th December and likely to be held in Pontypool Park, age group races. Time needed between races for athletes to leave and new to arrive. Volunteers will be needed, but they are allowed to have the same officials across all races. JT asked if the use of the same officials had been confirmed by Welsh Government as there had previously been issues with schools competition. Discussions

concerning if 'volunteers' acting as marshals were within the number of people allowed at an event. Will be held as a trial event, but details cannot be confirmed until Welsh Government have confirmed numbers possible.

- b. RSJ asked that any concerns to go through Rhiannon. JT to confirm the situation with RLP.

{PMN- JT spoke to RLP who is in correspondence WG however she is still waiting for clarification from Welsh Government on the exact requirements.}

- c. Regional Development Activities will be started back in December in Parc Bryn Bach.

vi. The provision for Photofinish training is currently being looked at. An update will be available at the next T & F Meeting. SH reported that Scotland are holding a photofinish course in December, pilot track and field course will be held online
