Legislation Linked to Events.

5.1 Risk Assessments

Required to be in writing under the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999. These should cover emergency actions, including Medical and Fire Risk Assessment.

5.2 Provision of Medical Services

Required under your obligations of "Duty of Care", "The Purple Guide to Health, Safety and Welfare at Music and Other Events (Events Industry Forum), Home Office "The Good Practice Safety Guide for small and sporting events taking place on the highway, roads and public places"

5.3 Food Hygiene Regulations 2013

Relates to Water Stations, Provision of catering by you or a sub-contractor.

5.4 Provision of Toilets

Required by "The Events Safety Guide" (Purple Guide) - See Fact Sheet Number 2.

5.5 Highways

5.6 Marquees

This is covered by The Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2015, the same as Temporary Structures.

5.7 Electrical Components & Wiring

Conforms to Electricity at Work Regulations 1989.

5.8 Temporary Structures

Compliance with Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 and Construction (Design and Management) Regulations (CDM) 2015. The Institute of Structural Engineers - Temporary demountable structures: Guidance on procurement, design and use (Fourth Edition 2017).
