3. Discussion

a) Matters arising from previous meeting – April 2021

b) Welsh Athletics Inter-Regional Cross Country Championships Selection Race - Cardiff Cross Challenge

The Cardiff event was the selection race for the Welsh Inter-Regional Cross Country Championships at Brecon on Saturday 20th November. Top 15 from U13, U15, U17, U20, Seniors & Masters age groups on the day have been selected from Cardiff Cross Challenge Results on Saturday 16th October. Athletes will be notified via club secretary/coaches in due course. Reserves / athletes that were unable to compete in Cardiff have been asked to shown interest should spaces arise.

c) West Wales Indoor Athletics Championships 2022

West Wales Indoor Athletics Championships due to be held on 15th/16th January 2022 at Swansea University Indoor Athletics Track but at present, the track is restricted to 60 people including athletes, parents, spectators, officials. As a result, it was agreed that it was not possible and practical to organise the championships in its normal format in 2022 at Swansea (West Wales venue).

It was proposed to incorporate the West Wales Indoor Championship events within the Welsh Athletics Junior Indoor Open at Cardiff on 5th December and 9th January (U13,

U15, U17) / or incorporate in the Welsh Athletics Junior & Senior Indoor Championships at Cardiff in January and February 2022.

Possible/an idea to perhaps organise an U11 event (boys and girls AM and PM) at Swansea in January depending on restrictions at the time.

New role being advertised by Welsh Athletics to support Endurance Officials in each region. It was agreed for Welsh Athletics (Zoe) to advertise this role & description via the website and social media for interest.

Confirmed: The West Wales Cross Country Championships will be held at Pembrey Country Park (in the region) on Saturday 4th December.
