

**Welsh Athletics Selection Policy for the
Pickering Memorial Throws International
Sunday 1st June 2025**

Overview

For the Pickering Memorial Throws International Welsh Athletics will select a team of U18, U20 and U23 Athletes to compete on the 1st June 2025, the below selection policy reflects the strategic aim of Welsh Athletics and the Performance pathway to support the pathway and preparation of athletes aspiring to be selected for a major championships.

The PMTI provides an International representative competition opportunity aimed at

- Focus on U20 and U23 athletes with a focus on Qualification for major championships
- Athletes within the current performance pathway program
- Athletes that are competing in Paralympic disciplines whom the selection panel believe can gain Paralympic futures or senior GB&NI selection at major events.

Athlete Eligibility

To be considered for selection for this team:

- Athletes must be eligible to compete for Wales. This includes holding a full British passport.
- Athletes must not be currently serving a period of ineligibility or a provisional or permanent suspension for a doping violation or for any other reason of misconduct.
- Athletes must be currently registered as a member with Welsh Athletics, directly or through a club.
- Para Athletes must have a current National or International Para Athletics Classification.
- Athletes will be required to sign the Welsh Athletics Team Members' Agreement and abide by its terms and conditions. Any athlete failing to do so before the date of the competition will result in their selection being withdrawn. Age classifications

- U23s = Athletes born in 2003, 2004 and 2005
- U20s = Athletes born in 2006 and 2007
- U18s = Athletes born in 2008 and 2009

Events

Welsh Athletics will select up to two people per event, max team size 12 male / 12 female

Olympic Disciplines: Shot put, discus, hammer, javelin

Paralympic Disciplines: Ambulant shot put, ambulant discus & ambulant javelin

Selection Process

- The selection meeting will take place on 13th May and final teams will be announced on 16th May.
- The teams will be selected by the Welsh Athletics Head of Performance and Welsh Athletics National Talent Development Coordinator (NTDC) for Throws.
- Selection of the team will use the following process to ensure the **selection policy aim** is met.
- Ambulant Throws events will be selected on ability to make the GB futures program and ability to obtain GB representation at Junior and senior World Championships and Paralympic Games.
- U18/U20/U23 athletes will be selected using the following criteria
 - Athletes will be selected in line with the Performance Pathway consideration standards and with the consideration of realistically making future GB representation and CWG teams. (Consideration standards can be found here <https://www.welshathletics.org/en/blog/post/performance-strategy-update>)
 - Priority 1: Athletes currently on Welsh Athletics support programmes (Performance Programme, Transition Programme and National Development Programme.)
 - Priority 2: Non-program athletes will be considered. Results and rankings of non-program athletes specifically looking at U18/U20/U23 GB representation.

There is no obligation to fill all available positions.

Appeals Process

There shall be no right to appeal against the selection of the Welsh team made by the selection panel.

De-selection Process

De-selection of an athlete may occur following:

1. Failure to adhere to the Welsh Athletics code of conduct
2. In the event of an athlete sustaining an injury or illness following acceptance of their position on the team, they are required to inform the team leader immediately. If required, evidence will have to be supplied. If it is deemed that the injury or illness will negatively affect the athlete's performance this will result in deselection.

Amendment

Welsh Athletics reserves the right to amend this selection policy at its sole discretion and will make any amended version publically available (including the date on which the amendment was made) on the [Welsh Athletics website](#)

Other Information

- The event will be run under World Athletics and World Para Athletics Rules.
- All implements entered, including personal implements, will be available to all competitors in that weight category. U20 and U18 Age Group athletes can elect to throw the appropriate weight implement for their age group. However, they must compete with that weight of implement for the entirety of the competition.
- Welsh Athletics will not provide financial assistance for travel to the meeting point at Loughborough, meals or snacks. Athletes based overseas will be required to cover their own travel expenses to the UK.
- Welsh Athletics will not provide overnight accommodation for the team.
- Welsh Athletics will provide competition kit to any athletes that haven't received such kit within the last 12 months.
- There will be support team coaches at this event, personal coaches are invited to attend and further entry information will be confirmed for spectators.
